

## Terms & Conditions

EasyIC, a Romanian Electronics company, wishes to promote excellence in electronic and microelectronic systems design in Romania. To further this goal, EasyIC is pleased to announce its Project competition open to all undergraduate students enrolled in electronics or microelectronics related courses at the [Transilvania University of Brasov](#).

The terms and conditions of the competition are as follows:

1. The competition is open to full-time students of relevant undergraduate programmes in the [Transilvania University of Brasov](#).
2. Students may submit an individual design and development project undertaken as part of their undergraduate studies and submitted to their college as such. Group projects may not be submitted.
3. The project must have a microelectronic or an electronic systems basis.
4. Students should fill out a brief Entry Form available from the EASYIC website
5. Students should submit a presentation slide set in pdf format describing their project. This presentation should contain 5 slides including:
  - What is the problem? - 1 slide
  - What is the solution? - 1 slide
  - Details of the implementation - 3 slides
    - Should include pictures, charts, diagrams

Focus should be on a visual presentation of your designs, concepts and results versus a written presentation.
6. An adjudication panel will assess each project and recommend three (3) projects to enter into a final.
7. A brief interview via phone or face-to-face may be used as part of the adjudication.
8. The judging criteria includes:
  - Novelty of the problem addressed
  - Creativity and quality of the project solution
  - Execution of the project
  - Issues addressed during project execution
9. In the final, each project will be presented for 10-15 minutes with a 10-15 minute Q&A. This will be in front of an audience of EasyIC staff including an adjudication panel. The winner will be announced after the presentations and awards made. The presentation is mandatory.

10. The (3-person) adjudication panel will be made up of senior management and engineering staff from EasyIC.
11. Latest date for submission of entries is 30<sup>th</sup> of April.
12. The winner will receive prize and the offer of an internship at EasyIC.
